**OPERA HOUSE (GB)**, Champion older horse in Europe in 1993, won 8 races at 2 to 5 years and £881,070 including Coronation Cup, **Gr.1**, Eclipse Stakes, **Gr.1**, King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes, **Gr.1**; sire.

**KAYF TARA (GB)**, won 10 races and £641,111 including Ascot Gold Cup, **Gr.1** (twice), Irish St Leger, **Gr.1** (twice), Goodwood Cup, **Gr.2**; sire.

**CEZANNE (GB)** (g. by Ajdal (USA)), Champion older horse in Ireland in 1994, won 10 races, £287,077 including Guinness Champion S, Leopardstown, **Gr.1**; sire.

**RAPPA TAP TAP (FR)** (f. by Tap On Wood), won 3 races including Blue Seal Stakes, Ascot, **L.**, fourth in Child Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3**; dam of winners.
