Online Health Documentation System (OHDS)

You can now upload CEMs, EVAs, Fillies' Examination Certificates, 15-Day Health Certificates etc., direct to any Lot for sale at Tattersalls Newmarket. No need to send paper copies to your clients. No last-minute chasing for documents you supplied but which didn't make it to the Sale ...

Documents you upload are visible online immediately to the Vendor of the Lot, so they can check they have all the documentation expected. Documents are visible to the public only once checked by Tattersalls.

As a Vet, you can use <u>https://secure.tattersalls.com/DocumentUploader</u> to upload and view documents for any Lots for sale. You should also notify us here online of any positive or questionable results.

If you already have a logon to upload images to the Tattersalls Repository, you can use the same logon for this. Otherwise, you can contact <u>bloodstock@tattersalls.com</u> to request access, or if you have a colleague at your practice who has been granted such access, they can click "Register a Colleague" to set that up for you.

Uploaded files should be single-page pdfs, but jpegs are OK too. (If taking photos of paper documents, please make sure they are clearly legible.) To upload a document for a Lot, click the relevant + icon. To upload in bulk, click "upload" and assign the documents to Lots/types afterwards.

NB: If uploading in bulk, you can save time if each file name indicates which Lot it is for and/or which type of document (CEM, EVA etc) it is. (The Lot number should be preceded by "Lot" if there are other numbers in the file name which could be confused. For document type, the filename should include the abbreviation shown at the top of the columns online, or as shown in the dropdown menu on the upload page.)
