Horses In and Out of Training, Point to Pointers, Stores, Two-Year-Olds
SALE DOCUMENTATION NOTICE

Please read the following instructions carefully, as failure to lodge the correct documentation will result in your Lot(s) being refused entry to Ascot Racecourse Stables. If you have any doubts regarding procedure for Sale documentation, please consult your veterinary surgeon or contact Liz Lane (liz.lane@tattersalls.com).

1. PASSPORTS (ALL LOTS) Compulsory

Passports and Flu Vaccinations must accompany the horses to the Sale and be presented and checked at the Control Office to gain entry. Passports will be held at the Control Office and can be collected with the correct Pass Out when taking the Sold or Not Sold Lot from the sale stables.

Please check that the markings in the passport match those of your Lot. Discrepancies must be notified immediately to the Stud Book Authority that hold the registration details of the Lot. Please also ensure that the Medicinal Treatment section of the passport (either A or B) is completed prior to Sale. Where a passport does not contain this section, please contact Weatherby's or the relevant Stud Book Authority so that the passport may be updated in advance of the Sale.

2. INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS (ALL LOTS) Compulsory

All lots must be fully vaccinated in accordance with the current British Horseracing Authority regulations.

Before 01/01/22

1st, 2nd (21 - 92 days), 3rd (150 – 215 days), booster not more than a year apart

After 01/01/22

1st, 2nd (21 – 60 days), 3rd (120 – 180 days), booster not more than 6 months apart

As a minimum, all lots must have had the first two vaccinations of the primary course. If due, the third vaccination of the primary course should be administered. Any further booster vaccinations should be dated within 6 months of the Sale. **The last vaccination must NOT be dated within 7 days of when the horse arrives on site.**

3. EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANAEMIA (EIA) (ALL LOTS) Compulsory

EIA testing must be carried out using the Coggins method and a blood sample should be taken within 70 days of the Sale for ALL Lots. This test should be carried out at the APHA Weybridge Laboratory in the UK, The Irish Equine Centre (IEC), or to an approved laboratory in the EU. This will expedite the export of those Lots returning to the EU or Northern Ireland after the Sale.

4. 30 DAY HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND 40 DAY RESIDENCY (ALL LOTS) Compulsory

This is a requirement and the approved wording template as per our main website, www.tattersalls.com, should be used. The 30-day Health Declaration should be completed by your Veterinary Surgeon and the 40-day Residency Declaration should be completed by the Vendor or the Vendor's Agent.

5. FILLIES' EXAMINATION CERTIFICATES (FILLIES IN/OUT OF TRAINING) Optional

To avoid numerous requests for examinations of their Lots during the Sale, Vendors may arrange for their veterinary surgeon to complete this form. Fillies' examination certificate templates are available to download from the Tattersalls website. Certificates should be dated within 30 days of the first day of Sale.
